6. **General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:**

The proposed ordinance is to approve the fourth amendatory agreement to a contract the City entered into February 20, 2007 (CE71037) with Earth Force Inc. (f/k/a Front Range Earth Force). The amendment provides additional funding to support Denver's Water Quality Public Education and Outreach Program, "Keep it Clean, from Drain to Stream," and annual planning for water quality programs. The cost to fund the scope of work for 2012 is \$116,800, raising the maximum contract amount to \$508,600.

Water quality public education and outreach is required under the Colorado Discharge Permit System (CDPS) Permit No. COS-000001 for stormwater discharges from the City's Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) under the following Permit areas:

1. Parts I.B.1.b.(4-6) of the Illicit Discharges Management Program; and
2. Parts I.B.1.f.(3 and 4) of the Additional Requirements - Seg. 14 of the S. Platte Only (*E. coli* Management Program).

The goal of the *Keep it Clean* campaign is to foster behavioral change among residents to prevent or mitigate water quality impairment through a multi-departmental effort managed by the Department of Public Works, Wastewater Management Division.

Benefits: The proposed ordinance provides continued funding for water quality public education and outreach to Denver citizens as required by Colorado Discharge Permit System Permit No. COS-000001. The water quality program is necessary for the health, safety, comfort, convenience, and welfare of all the people of the City, region and State.

f. Costs: Program costs for 2012 are \$116,800; the additional funding raises the maximum contract amount to \$508,600.
