To address the interconnected challenges of food insecurity, limited educational opportunities, and systemic barriers faced by the youth in our community, FLF's innovative, youth-centered programs will directly improve nutrition knowledge, food skills and healthy eating environments for children, families, and caregivers in Denver. This work is anchored in an enduring commitment to blending (a) on-farm experiential education with (b) immediate access to healthy, locally grown food; and (c) curricula that foster the contextual knowledge, skills, and senses of dignity and self-worth that young people need to step capably and confidently into their roles as changemakers within their communities. In the near term, FLF feeds, teaches, and engages youth from early elementary through high school. In the long term, FLF's communities are strengthened by well-nourished leaders who prioritize health and wellbeing by attending to the vital connections among and between humans and ecosystems, mediated every day through food.
