A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase from the Denver Sheriff Department State Grant Special Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS, the Denver Sheriff Department (DSD) is seeking approval to purchase a Handheld Mass Spec Chemical Detection System to scan for potentially dangerous contraband substances, including drugs and other illicit substances; and

WHEREAS, said purchase will be authorized from the "FY24-25 Drug and Contraband Detection and Control Grant" program budget (12301-3531000); and

WHEREAS, said item is over the \$50,000 threshold for capital equipment items that require City Council approval, per the Denver Revised Municipal Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Denver Sheriff Department State Grant Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 12301, the Executive Director of the Department of Safety, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:

Section 2. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
