Denver International Airport (DEN) is seeking approval for capital equipment purchases of replacement vehicles. Said vehicles will replace assets which have exceeded their anticipated service life and are generating disproportionately high maintenance and repair costs due to age and accumulated usage. Continued investment in these assets is no longer cost-effective and presents increasing risk to budget stability. Timely replacement will reduce escalating maintenance expenditures and support fiscally responsible asset management while ensuring uninterrupted daily operations at DEN. Of the sixteen assets, thirteen DEN vehicles are proposed to be replaced with electric zero-emission vehicles. The remaining three vehicles are Denver Police Department (DPD) units that will be replaced like-for-like due to the operational demands of 24/7 utilization.
