Contract PLANE-202579248 establishes on-call services for qualified contractors to provide comprehensive landside facilities, maintenance and repair support as required on an as needed basis. Services encompass a broad range of trades, including electrical systems (power, lighting, low-voltage, life safety, and medium-voltage), HVAC, plumbing, carpentry, glazing, painting, appliance and car washing repair, and fire protection services. The work scope includes routine preventive maintenance, corrective repairs, and specialized projects associated with landside interior and exterior infrastructure.

These contracts are intended to support critical landside infrastructure by providing preventative maintenance, corrective repairs, and small- to large-scale facility improvements across the DEN campus. The program aligns with DEN’s Vision 100 strategic pillar, “Maintaining What We Have,” by improving asset reliability, reducing operational downtime, and extending the service life of mechanical, electrical, plumbing, life safety, and structural systems.

Scope of work:

Denver International Airport (DEN) is establishing On-Call Landside Facilities Maintenance and Repair Services contracts to provide responsive, flexible trade services on an as-needed basis. These contracts support modifications, repairs, additions, and maintenance of existing landside airport facilities and systems through individually defined task orders.

The scope of services includes, but is not limited to, furnishing and installation of electrical systems and components such as power distribution, equipment and circuiting, lighting, low-voltage and special systems, life safety systems, medium-voltage infrastructure, and related disciplines. Additional trade services include Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC); plumbing; building trades (including carpentry, glazing, car wash repairs, and appliance services); and painting services supporting landside interior and exterior infrastructure.

These contracts are intended to support critical landside infrastructure by providing preventative maintenance, corrective repairs, and small- to large-scale facility improvements across the DEN campus. The program aligns with DEN's Vision 100 strategic pillar, "Maintaining What We Have," by improving asset reliability, reducing operational downtime, and extending the service life of mechanical, electrical, plumbing, life safety, and structural systems.

Work will be issued through individual task orders with clearly defined scopes, schedules, and pricing utilizing time-and-materials or competitive bidding, as appropriate. Contractors are required to provide licensed and skilled trade personnel across multiple disciplines and maintain strict compliance with quality, safety, regulatory, and airport operational requirements. These contracts emphasize rapid response to urgent and emergency conditions, coordination with DEN stakeholders, and uninterrupted landside operations.
