11	established through Ordinance No. 293, Series of 2020, which also authorized a rescission from	
12	General Fund contingency, and a transfer to this SRF to support the City's response to the	
13	pandemic; and	
14	WHEREAS, said fund was subsequently supported by revenue from additional General	
15	Fund transfers (authorized through Ordinance No. 915, Series of 2020, and Ordinance No. 1425,	
16	Series of 2021) as well as a transfer from the City's TABOR reserve through Ordinance No. 357,	
17	Series of 2020; and	
18	WHEREAS, while the City fronted dollars to address the pandemic, the Department of	
19	Finance (DOF) applied for federal reimbursement for FEMA-eligible expenses, anticipating that	
20	these reimbursements would be made in 2024; and	
21	WHEREAS, the City planned the 2024 budget for All in Mile High with the knowledge that	
22	these dollars were forthcoming; and	
23	WHEREAS, the City wishes to transfer cash from FEMA reimbursements to the General	
24	Fund and increase the Department of Housing Stability's (HOST) appropriation to support the	
25	City's All in Mile High Initiative;
