A. Number. The Commission shall consist of no less than seven (7) and no more than twenty-one (21) members. All members of the Commission (commissioners) shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council acting by resolution.

B. Composition. Appointments to the Commission shall mirror, as much as possible, the demographics of the population of Denver County. Demographic considerations for each commission should include ethnicity, gender, race, age, sexual orientation, disability, political viewpoints and affiliations, and geographic location. Each commission will track relevant demographic information and commissioner skills on a diversity matrix in order to identify areas for targeted recruitment efforts annually.
