The new vehicle will be specifically designed to support high-risk explosive and tactical response operations, enhance regional and national response capabilities, and ensure compliance with FBI and NBSCAB standards. Equipped with advanced technologies, robotics, x-ray systems, and command post functionality, these vehicles will significantly improve reliability, adaptability to emerging threats, and coordination across jurisdictions. This investment strengthens the broader emergency response infrastructure across the North Central Region and Colorado Front Range, ensuring public safety and operational readiness in both urban and rural environments.
