### Finance & Services

- RR14- Approves the levying upon all taxable property within the City taxes for 1070 the year 2014, to be collected in 2015, for purposes authorized by law.
- RR14- Approves the levying upon all taxable property within the City taxes for 1082 the year 2014 for purposes authorized by law for School District No. 1.
- RR14- Approves the levying upon all taxable property within special districts 1083 within the City for purposes authorized by law for special districts for the year 2014.
- BR14- Establishes the Assistance Incentives Program Special Revenue Fund for 1110 Denver Department of Human Services for incentives received from the State of Colorado for support activities for Medicaid and other assistance programs.
- BR14- Approves a \$5,338,820 purchase and sale agreement between the City 1115 and Belle Haven Realty Co. for land and improvements located at 2100 31st Street for a new service center for City fleet and the Electronic Engineering Bureau in Council District 9 (201419298).

District 7.

1108 Jerrold Glick, and Michael West to the Denver Union Station Project  
Authority Board of Directors for terms effective 1-1-15 and expiring 12-  
31-16.
