6 **A BILL**

7 **For an ordinance designating certain properties as being required for public use**
8 **and authorizing use and acquisition thereof by negotiation or through**
9 **condemnation proceedings of fee simple, easement and other interests,**
10 **including any rights and interests related or appurtenant to properties**
11 **designated as needed for the completion of the Sanderson Gulch Trail Multi-**
12 **Modal Safety Improvement Project in Council District 7. This includes easement**
13 **interests, access rights and any improvements on the property as part of the**
14 **project.**

15 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

16 **Section 1.** That the Council hereby designates the following properties situated in the City
17 and County of Denver and State of Colorado as being needed for public uses and purposes by the
18 City and County of Denver, a municipal corporation of the State of Colorado:

8 **Section 2.** That the Council finds and determines that property interests in these properties
9 are needed and required for the following public uses and public purposes: for the construction of
10 the Sanderson Gulch Trail Multi-Modal Safety Improvement Project. This includes easement
11 interests, access rights and any improvements on the property as part of the project.

12 **Section 3.** That Council authorizes the Mayor, including his duly authorized representatives,
13 in accordance with applicable federal, state, and City laws and rules and regulations adopted
14 pursuant thereto, to acquire the needed property interests, including, but not limited to, fee title,
15 permanent easements, temporary easements, fixtures, licenses, permits, improvements (including
16 without limitation, general outdoor advertising devices, buildings, and access points) and any other
17 rights, interests, and appurtenances thereto. Such authority includes the taking of all actions
18 necessary to do so without further action by City Council, including but not limited to: conducting
19 negotiations, executing all related agreements, making all necessary payments, taking any and all
20 actions required by law before instituting condemnation proceedings, allowing the temporary use of
21 City-owned land and conveying all or a portion of any City-owned land, including remnants, by
22 quitclaim deed, permanent or temporary easements, leases, licenses and permits.

23 **Section 4.** That if the interested parties do not agree upon the compensation to be paid for
24 the needed property interests, the owner or owners of the property are incapable of consenting, the
25 name or residence of any owner is unknown, or any of the owners are non-residents of the State,
26 then the City Attorney of the City and County of Denver, upon the Mayor's direction, is authorized
27 and empowered to exercise the City and County of Denver's eminent domain powers by instituting
28 and, as necessary, prosecuting to conclusion proceedings under Article 1, Title 38, Colorado
29 Revised Statutes, to acquire needed property interests upon, through, over, under and along the
30 above-described property as necessary for the purposes set forth in Section 2 above.

31 **Section 5.** That the Council finds and determines that the Denver Department of
32 Transportation and Infrastructure and federal and state agencies may find the need to alter the

1 nature of the property interests or the legal descriptions of the properties referred to in this Ordinance
2 and may continue to do so in order to meet the needs of the Project. Council authorizes the Mayor,
3 including his duly authorized representatives, in accordance with applicable federal, state, and City
4 laws and rules and regulations adopted pursuant thereto, to acquire the property as the property
5 interests and legal descriptions are altered in accordance with the means authorized in this
6 Ordinance.

7 **Section 6.** That the Council hereby finds and determines that to improve the safety and
8 operation of pedestrians, bicycles and vehicles in the vicinity of the Project, it may be necessary to
9 rebuild, modify, remove, and relocate existing access points to streets located in the vicinity of the
10 Project.

11 **Section 7.** That the Council authorizes the City to acquire through negotiated purchase or
12 condemnation all or any portion of any property interest as needed for the construction of Sanderson
13 Gulch Trail Multi-Modal Safety Improvement Project.

14 **Section 8.** That the City Council hereby finds and determines that the Project is necessary
15 for the health, safety, and welfare of the public.
