Executive Summary Fax-Mayfair BID Creation Ordinance

Business Improvements Districts (BID's) are organized for the benefit of commercial properties to assist with infrastructure improvements and their maintenance, as well as having the ability to perform marketing and economic development activities.

The Fax-Mayfair BID is a business improvement district organized pursuant to the Business Improvement District Act, Section 31-25-1201 *et seq.*, Colorado Revised Statutes. The main purpose of the BID is to improve the economic vitality and overall commercial appeal located along both sides of Colfax from Elm Street to Monaco Parkway and includes the area known as the Mayfair Town Center area between Kearney and Leyden from Colfax Avenue south to 14th Ave.

The Fax-Mayfair BID will be a commercial property owner funded management district that provides the following services and improvements: economic development services, physical improvements, safety, and advocacy on behalf of corridor property and businesses.

The estimated 2015 budget is anticipated to be approximately \$118,000. The budget is expected to be funded primarily through assessments applied against the assessed value of the taxable commercial property within the BID.

The Board of Directors of the District (the "Board") shall consist of seven (7) electors of the District, appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council resolution. The initial members of the Board are proposed as follows: John Bachmann, mark Berzins, Dave Emick, Jamie Harris, Barbara McFarlane, Dan Murray, Candace Wikstrom.
