This new contract will allow for the implementation of a POS (point of sale) system for use at the following Denver Parks and Recreation agencies; Permitting, Event Venues, Recreation Centers, Marketing, Buffalo Bill Museum, Chief Hosa Campground, City Wide Sports, Youth Sports, Outdoor Pools, Adaptive Recreation, Community Recreation Outdoor Recreation, and Finance. The system contract will be five years in duration and the implementation period is 11 months beginning in January 2014. The system will provide point of sale and online payments for merchandise and services, receipting and cash handling functions and will fully support required city PCI (Payment Card Industry) requirements.
