



The below arrests were processed by officers participating in the curfew program

2016 = 416 out of 571 total arrests

2017 = 342 out of 434 total arrests

2018 = 80 arrests thru May 23rd, 2018

All curfew violators are not processed through the Curfew Program/Safe Nights. During the times in which the program is not in effect, violators are cited by district personnel and transported home. The program runs from April thru September. The officers involved in the program are responsible for initiating contact with suspected violators while also responding to requests from patrol personnel.
