**A BILL**

**For an ordinance concerning the salaries of county court judges.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** That subsection 14-2 (b), D.R.M.C. shall be amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

**Sec. 14-2. Number and salary of judges.**

(b) Each county judge shall be paid a salary equal to a compa-ratio of ~~4.076~~ 1.039 of the pay grade ~~821-L~~ applicable to the job classification entitled "Assistant City Attorney—Section Supervisor" in the legal occupational group ~~in~~ of the classification and pay plan adopted and maintained in accordance with chapter 18, division 2 of article II; provided, however, in no event shall any judge's salary be reduced during the judge's term of office.

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall be effective January 1, 2014.
