 - a. Scope of Work**

This Ordinance will authorize the appropriation of the 2012 funding from the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) authorized by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Awarded annually, the Emergency Solutions Grant has provided a stable source of funds to help meet emergency services needed to address the amelioration of poverty. The grant program operates on a fiscal year beginning January 1st. For the FY 2012, it is estimated that Denver Human Services award will be \$389,480 based on the received Letter of Intent. The official grant awards letters are generally not received until the springtime.
