Second Chance Center was recently selected by the Crime Prevention and Control Commission through a competitive solicitation to provide reentry services in Denver. Second Chance Center will work in conjunction with other local service providers to provide supportive services to individuals exiting the Denver jail system to reduce recidivism. Second Chance Center will follow the Transition from Jail to Community (TJC) model, an evidence-based practice that has been shown to be successful by targeting interventions to address an individual's specific criminogenic risk factors.
