A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase in the Denver Arts and Venues Special Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS, the current soundboard at Boettcher Concert Hall, home of the Colorado Symphony, has exceeded its useful life and no longer supports the technical requirements of the venue; and

WHEREAS, said equipment will significantly improve audio quality, reliability, and functionality for symphonic and other live performances and events at Boettcher Concert Hall; and

WHEREAS, this bill request authorizes the purchase of a soundboard control surface and associated components;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Denver Arts and Venues Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 15815, the Executive Director of Denver Arts and Venues, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:
