A BILL

For an ordinance establishing a new fund in the Culture and Recreation Special Revenue Fund for the “Denver Public Library Local and Private Grants” program.

WHEREAS, the Denver Public Library requests a new fund to receive local and private grants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. A new fund is hereby established in the Culture and Recreation Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 15000, a “Denver Public Library Local and Private Grants”, Accounting No. 15609 for the purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of the Denver Public Library’s local and private grants.

Section 2. Monies received from private grant awards and local grant awards shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 15000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. Expenditures are hereby authorized for the “Denver Public Library Local and Private Grants” Fund, Accounting No. 15609, in the amount not to exceed the amounts awarded by the grantors as described in Section 2 of this Ordinance, to be expended by the City Librarian.

Section 4. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
