This capacity increase and extension will continue to allow The Greenway Foundation to provide advisory services to the City of Denver and advocate on behalf of projects related to the South Platte River and its tributaries (FINAN-201415058-03).

**5. General description or background of proposed request. Attach executive summary if more space needed:**

The Greenway Foundation Contract (FINAN-201415058) was approved and adopted by City Council in 2014 and has since been amended to add additional capacity while extending the contract term so that The Greenway Foundation could continue to provide advisory services to the City of Denver and advocate on behalf of projects related to the South Platte River and its tributaries. The contract currently has a capacity of \$989,000 and a term ending on 12/31/2019. This amendment proposes to increase the master on-call contract amount by \$200K and amend the term end date to 12/31/2021. The City & County of Denver and The Greenway Foundation have a long and successful history of partnering on projects that advance the Foundation's mission of reclaiming, redeveloping, and protecting the South Platte River (and surrounding tributaries) as a unique environmental, recreational, cultural, scientific and historical amenity. Through this contract, the departments of Public Works, Parks and Recreation, and Department of Public Health and Environment (DDPHE), and the Mayor's Office of the National Western Center negotiate individual task orders for tasks including, but not limited to, project advocacy and fundraising on behalf of projects related to water quality, ecosystem restoration, flood risk reduction, recreation along the South Platte River and surrounding tributaries, and environmental education programs. The Department of Finance manages the contract for the purpose of authorizing work performed, tracking budget capacity, keeping a master calendar and coordinating/avoiding duplication of services between user agencies.
