A BILL

For an ordinance making a rescission from and an appropriation in the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1216, Series of 2020, appropriated personnel expenses for staff time spent related to project management activities on capital projects; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the project budget was not expended due to the number of vacancies in 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to transfer remaining project funds to the Public Works Improvement Projects Fund to support expenses for the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From appropriations heretofore made from the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded":
