15 16 **WHEREAS**, the State of Colorado, Department of Local Affairs, has sent a letter of intent
16 17 (LOI) to Denver Human Services stating their intent to provide Community Services Block Grant
17 18 (CSBG) funds in the amount of \$853,000 for the 2026 program year; and18 19 **WHEREAS**, per Fiscal Rule 9.1, if the award is not received, or the final award amount is
19 20 reduced, Denver Human Services has agreed to identify budget to fund all related expenditures;
20 21 and21 22 **WHEREAS**, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said letter of intent,
22 23 a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 20260009;24 25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF
DENVER:**26 27 **Section 1.** Expenditures are hereby authorized from the Human Services Special Revenue
27 28 Fund, Accounting No. 13000, the amounts of money in the following tabulation to be expended for
