A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing expenditures in the Human Services Special Revenue Fund based on a letter of intent from the State of Colorado to award funding to the City and County of Denver for the “Community Services Block Grant (CSBG)” program for the 2026 program year.

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado, Department of Local Affairs, has sent a letter of intent (LOI) to Denver Human Services stating their intent to provide Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) funds in the amount of \$853,000 for the 2026 program year; and

WHEREAS, per Fiscal Rule 9.1, if the award is not received, or the final award amount is reduced, Denver Human Services has agreed to identify budget to fund all related expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said letter of intent, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 20260009;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Expenditures are hereby authorized from the Human Services Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 13000, the amounts of money in the following tabulation to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
