This amendment will commit an additional \$2,650,000 in Mile High Flood District (UDFCD) funds, and \$3,718,816.59 in Wastewater Enterprise funds for the Globeville Levee Project to design and construct drainage and flood control improvements for a total of \$6,368,816.59. The improvements will include drainage, habitat, water quality, and recreation improvements for the Globeville Levee from 31st Street to East 50th Avenue. This project is being managed through design and construction by the MHFD (UDFCD)..

The Mile High Flood District (aka Urban Drainage and Flood Control District) and the City and County of Denver are working together to design approximately 7,900 linear feet of improvements to the existing levee which are needed to reduce the risk of river flooding in the Globeville/ Utah Junction drainage basin, and to comply with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) freeboard requirements.

Scope of work: The Globeville Levee project was identified as a key project to reduce flood risk in the Globeville/Utah Junction basin. The Globeville Stormwater System Study identified that the height of the existing levee located along the west side of the South Platte River, next to the existing trail, is approximately 2 feet lower than the 3 feet minimum freeboard required by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) in most locations, and identified a spill location during a 100-year storm even just south of 38th Street on the west bank of the river, south and upstream of the existing levee. The GSSS evaluated options and provided recommendations for reducing the risk of river flooding to avoid floodplain re-designation from this spill. This IGA will support the design work necessary to complete the final construction plans for the levee improvements, needed to meet FEMA requirements.
