**A BILL**

**For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase from the Wildland Fire Reimbursement Fee Program Special Revenue Fund.**

**WHEREAS**, the Denver Fire Department (DFD) Wildland Firefighting Program is requesting to purchase a "Type 3" Wildland Fire Engine Apparatus to be used to help with wildland fires across the U.S., as well as locally in the metro area and within the state of Colorado; and

**WHEREAS**, said purchase will be authorized from the DFD Wildland Fire Reimbursement Fee Programs Special Revenue Fund (12825); and

**WHEREAS**, said vehicle is over the \$50,000 threshold for capital equipment items that require City Council approval, per the Denver Revised Municipal Code;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** From the Wildland Fire Reimbursement Fee Program Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 12825, the Executive Director of the Department of Safety, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:
