**A RESOLUTION**

**Approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Human Services, Behavioral Health Administration, for the “Criminal Justice Early Intervention Grant” program and the funding therefor, supersedes Resolution 951, series of 2024.**

**WHEREAS**, the Colorado Department of Human Services, Behavioral Health Administration, for the “Criminal Justice Early Intervention Grant” program was approved via resolution 951, series of 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, this resolution supersedes resolution 951, series of 2024 to correct the Section 3 table Accounting Number to the Public Health Federal Grant Fund (14001); and

**WHEREAS**, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** The proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Human Services, Behavioral Health Administration, for the “Criminal Justice Early Intervention Grant” program, which is identified as Grant Number 25 IBEH 189811, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 202474524 be and hereby is approved in all respects.

**Section 2.** The payments made by the Colorado Department of Human Services, Behavioral Health Administration, to the City pursuant to and under the amended Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 14000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

**Section 3.** That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Executive Director of Denver Department of Public Health and Environment, is as follows:
