[19-0283](#) Authorizes the issuance of City and County of Denver General Obligation Bonds, Series 2019A-B in a principal amount not to exceed \$139 million, for the purpose of funding approximately \$82 million of Elevate Denver bond projects identified as part of the 2017 GO Bond authorization, to refund existing Series 2009A Better Denver and Zoo General Obligation Bonds, and to pay associated costs of issuance.

Consent Items

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- [19-0250](#) Amends a contract with Wolters Kluwer Financial Services Inc. by adding \$396,169 for a new total of \$592,996.62 and five years for a new end date of 12-31-23 for recordkeeping, workpaper, and auditing software to support the operations of the Auditor's Office, citywide (CE7A063-06).
- [19-0286](#) Amends an on-call contract with AOR, Incorporated by adding \$480,000 for a new total of \$830,000 and expanding the scope of work to include additional marketing and creative services for planning, managing, facilitating, and implementing marketing and branding initiatives for all city programs, projects, events, and priorities, citywide. No change to contract duration (TECHS-201738497).
- [19-0290](#) Appropriates \$7,690,277 of the Federal Head Start grant to operate the Denver Great Kids Head Start program through the Office of Children's Affairs to provide services to 1,153 children in the established service area.
