**A BILL**

**For an ordinance making a cash transfer from the Coronavirus Emergency Response Special Revenue Fund to the General Fund and authorizing appropriations in the Housing Stability General Fund.**

**WHEREAS**, the City and County of Denver has in place a state of emergency regarding unsheltered residents, as initiated by Mayor Mike Johnston and approved by Denver City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City’s 2022 Point in Time Count (annual survey of the number of people experiencing homelessness) counted more than 1,300 residents unsheltered and living outdoors on a single night in January; and

**WHEREAS**, the number of unsheltered individuals has increased year-over-year and is expected to continue to increase; and

**WHEREAS**, the increasing number of people living unsheltered in the City creates significant public health and safety risks due to the lack of available services and the associated impacts of encampments created in spaces that are not intended for habitation; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 293, Series of 2020, established the Coronavirus Emergency Response Special Revenue Fund to support General Fund agencies’ response to the pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the revenue to the Coronavirus Emergency Response Special Revenue Fund was General Fund transfers and transfers from TABOR Reserves; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 293, Series of 2020 authorized the Chief Financial Officer to transfer cash balances to the General Fund after the City’s response to the pandemic is complete; and

**WHEREAS**, the federal government declared the emergency to be over in May of 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to transfer the remaining cash balance from the Coronavirus Emergency Response Special Revenue Fund (SRF) to the Department of Housing Stability’s General Fund appropriation to support Mayor Johnston’s *House 1000 Initiative*;

1           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY**  
2 **OF DENVER:**

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4           **Section 1:** There is hereby authorized the transfer of cash in the amount indicated in the  
5 following tabulation:

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8 The forgoing is to make a cash transfer in an amount equal to the remaining cash balance in the  
9 Coronavirus Emergency Response SRF to the Department of Housing Stability's General Fund  
10 appropriation. This amount is estimated to be approximately \$8.0 million but may be adjusted as  
11 transactions are finalized.

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13           **Section 2.** From the General Fund, Accounting No. 01010, out of monies transferred in Section  
14 1 and not otherwise appropriated and in addition to amounts heretofore appropriated by Ordinance  
15 No. 1446, Series of 2022, and any supplemental appropriations or rescissions, there is hereby  
16 appropriated to the appropriation accounts hereinafter designated the amount of money, following  
17 such designation, to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance  
18 set forth:

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20 This amount reflects the transfer authorized in Section 1 and is estimated to be approximately \$8.0  
21 million. The amount may be adjusted as transactions in the Coronavirus Emergency Response SRF  
22 are finalized.


1           **Section 3.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary  
3 to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
