17	WHEREAS, in spring of 2022, the Presiding Judge approved an increase in parking fines
18	resulting in an increase of \$6.4 million in revenue that was not accounted for in the 2022 budget;

20	WHEREAS, the City wishes to appropriate the revenue associated with the increase in
21	parking fines in the General Fund (01010) and then transfer it to the Transportation and Mobility
22	Fund (11882); and
23	Whereas, a portion of said transferred funds will be transferred to the Transportation and
24	Mobility Capital Fund (34801) to support capital projects;
