**a. Scope of Work**

CCD is mandated by the DCC to exchange our frequencies with those provided by Sprint Nextel to eliminate interference to our 800MHz radio systems. This involves all 800MHz radio users within the CCD including DIA, along with additional system users which the City provides services. The scope of work involves retuning our existing radios and replacing radios that are not able to be retuned. We have developed a scope of work to not interfere with the day-to-day operations of the City radio systems with all costs associated to be paid by Nextel. The amendment contains a minor change to the scope of work and costs associated with the project.
