



Committee Consent Agenda

Government & Finance

- BR12- 0892 Appropriates \$10,462,511.84 for the 2013 Self-Insured Dental Fund (the City contributes an estimated 68% or \$7,114,535; employees' 32% or \$3,347,976) for dental benefits for City employees.
- BR12- 0893 Appropriates \$5,844,472.28 for 2013 flexible benefit programs primarily funded by employees (\$4,630,012.38 for Medical Care, \$1,063,520.30 for Dependent Care, and \$150,939.60 for the Qualified Parking Program).
- BR12- 0894 Approves a \$1,100,000 supplemental request for Arts and Venues Denver Special Revenue Fund due to increased expenditures for additional events. Combined with a previously approved supplemental, the total 2012 supplemental appropriation is \$3,600,000, which is offset by increased revenue from the events of \$7,155,340 with no General Fund impact (15815-3050000).
- BR12- 0898 Extends the current Comcast Franchise Agreement for 6 months to July 1, 2013 while negotiations are completed (RC9Y007).

Health, Safety, Education & Services

- BR12- 0895 Accepts and expends the second allocation award in the amount of \$219,083 for a total award of \$608,563 for the 2011 Emergency Solutions Grant provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for support of emergency services for homeless individuals (GC11005 (01)).

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

- BR12- 0896 Relinquishes easements at 2907 Huron to accommodate redevelopment in Council District 9 (Reception No 2007027330).

BR12- Vacates a portion of Wewatta at 21st Street adjacent to 2100 Delgany
0897 for redevelopment in Council District 9.

BR12- Amends the contract with ACME Tree Service, the first responder for on-
0899 call City-Wide Emergency and Enforcement Service, to increase it from
\$450,000 to \$875,000 with the same end date of June 30, 2014 (OC
03062).

Routine, non-controversial requests for ordinances that are not substantive policy changes may be placed on Consent Agendas for Council Committees each week with the approval of Committee chairs. Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion. If approved, items are placed on the Mayor-Council agenda the following week. This document outlines the items that were placed on consent agendas this week.
