15	(b) (2) The non-profit corporation's board of directors shall be composed of thirteen (13)				
16	members appointed in the following fashion:

11	year, two (2) with a first term of two (2) years and one (1) with a first term of three (3) years. All				
12	subsequent terms shall be three (3) years. Members of the board may serve no more than three (3)				
13	terms in total. If an appointment remains vacant for more than sixty (60) days, the remainder of the				
14	board, by a majority vote, shall fill the vacancy with a person that will closely represent the interests of				
15	the vacant member's seat; provided, however, that before the non-profit corporation has been formed				
16	and, if necessary, before its status as a tax exempt entity has been approved by the Internal Revenue				
17	Service ("IRS"), it shall be sufficient that a majority of the board members has been appointed and tha				
18	majority acts to achieve the aforementioned formation and IRS approval. Nothing in this section shall				
19	prevent the board from removing a member as authorized by its bylaws. City officials designated				
20	above serve at the pleasure of the mayor.
