Department of Transportation and Infrastructure (DOTI) 2025 Large General Civil On-Call Construction Services Contracts

DOTI is seeking to establish a group of qualified On-Call Prime General Contractors available to respond to proposal bidding requests for the execution of construction work for the City's infrastructure.

Purpose and Use of Agreements:

The purpose of these On-Call contracts is to establish and maintain a pool of qualified On-Call Prime General Contractors available to respond to proposal bidding requests for the execution of construction work typically within the City's Right-of-Way. At a total capacity of \$400M, these contracts will support delivery of Transportation Infrastructure projects. Each contract has a 12% MWBE goal.

The 2025 Large General Civil On-Call Construction contract will be utilized to construct a variety of improvements to the City and County of Denver's infrastructure. These improvements may include but are not limited to: preconstruction services; intersection construction, roadway construction; improvements to bike lanes, sidewalks, curb, gutter, Vision Zero, and accessible ramps; pavement rehabilitation; traffic signals, lighting, ITS, and telecommunication facilities; signing and striping construction; landscape improvements and ultra-urban green infrastructure; pond improvements; bridge work; maintenance of traffic; public information; and storm sewer and sanitary sewer construction.

Procurement:

Nineteen (19) firms submitted qualification submittals of which seventeen (17) were reviewed and scored. Of those submittals, eight (8) firms were selected.

Contracts Description:

Each contract has a three (3) year term and a capacity of \$50 million. The firms selected are listed alphabetically.
