**A RESOLUTION**

**Approving and providing for the execution of a proposed amended Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Human Services concerning the “Colorado Community Response” program and the funding therefor.**

**WHEREAS**, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed amended Grant Agreement;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** The proposed amended Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Human Services’ Office of Early Childhood, for the “Colorado Community Response” program, which is identified as Grant Number 21 IHIA 159798, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 202055469, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

**Section 2.** The payments made by the State of Colorado to the City pursuant to and under the amended Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 13000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

**Section 3.** That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Executive Director of Denver Human Services, is as follows:

The foregoing amendment increases the current grant authorization from \$450,000 to \$590,790. Authorization for expenditures of said funds will cover the period from July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2021.
