A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase in the General Government Special Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS, the Office of Emergency Management (OEM) is seeking approval to purchase ten (10) Mobile Detection Units to support the operations of the Office of Emergency Management (OEM) "Securing the Cities Grant" Program, which was approved via Resolution 883, Series of 2022; and

WHEREAS, said units can be mounted on vehicles, ATVs, aircraft, and be used as portal monitors for monitoring special events and conducting pre-event sweeps of outdoor event spaces/regions to scan for neutron and gamma radiation associated with nuclear threats and/or radioactivity which can damage human cells; and

WHEREAS, said purchase will be authorized from the OEM "FY21 Securing the Cities" Grant program budget (11001-0160000); and

WHEREAS, said Mobile Detection Units are each over the \$50,000 threshold for capital equipment items that require City Council approval, per the Denver Revised Municipal Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Securing the Cities Grants Fund, Accounting No. 11000, the Executive Director of the Office of Emergency Management, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:
