7 **For an ordinance amending Article II of Chapter 15 of the Revised Municipal Code**
8 **for purposes of approving a new redistricting plan for the eleven council districts**
9 **of the City and County of Denver for the municipal election on April 4, 2023, and**
10 **for any general or special council election held thereafter.**

12 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

13 **Section 1.** That section 15-17 of the Revised Municipal Code, entitled "Boundaries and
14 precinct plan for the council districts for municipal elections conducted on or after January 1, 2018"
15 and relating to council districts is hereby repealed and the section is amended by re-enacting a
16 new section 15-17 to read as follows:

17 **Sec. 15-17. - Boundaries and precinct plan for the council districts for municipal elections**
18 **conducted on or after April 4, 2023.**

19 For all municipal general and special elections conducted on or after April 4, 2023, the precincts
20 for the eleven (11) council districts shall be as described below. The districts shall consist of whole
21 election precincts as depicted on the precinct map set by the Denver Clerk and Recorder on
22 December 7, 2021 and the district boundaries shall be as depicted on the map on file in the office
23 of the Clerk and Recorder at City Clerk Filing No. 20220030.
