Approves amendment with Anglin Civil, LLC, to increase the maximum liability to \$89,500,000. Beginning with the 2024-2025 snow season additional services areas will include the deice pads, and the Inner and Outer Vehicle Service Roads (VSR's). The additional areas of coverage include nine (9) deice pads, Taxiways J, K, and H (non-movement areas controlled by the City or United Airlines), City operated gates, and approximately 27.7 miles of Vehicle Service Roads used by all DEN stakeholders. The Airlines are requesting increased levels of service on the ramp areas. With current staffing levels DEN is unable to meet that request. By utilizing Anglin Civil, LLC, this allows DEN staff to concentrate on the runways, movement area taxiways (Federal Aviation Administration controlled), and roadways. Anglin Civil, LLC provides all supervision, labor, equipment, equipment maintenance, and operational support to maintain commercial airline ramp operations and complete melting operations.

**Scope of work:** Anglin Civil, LLC, provides assistance with DEN’s Airside annual snow removal operations during the snow season, October – April. The contract provides comprehensive snow removal services to ensure safe and efficient operations on deice pads, ramp areas, and Vehicle Services Roads (VSR’s), City operated gates, and areas prioritized by airlines and Airport Operations. Anglin Civil, LLC shall clear the main ramp area of snow to promote safe aircraft operations. The ramp shall be cleared so that surface markings and lighting are visible and ice buildup is prevented. Taxi lanes must be kept free of windrows or piles and in acceptable condition to allow safe aircraft operations. Lead in lines need to be visible 80% - 90% of the time and cleared 35 – 40 feet wide at all times. Snow Melting operations shall be performed continuously throughout the snow events, unless officially notified by the DEN Maintenance Leadership. Anglin Civil, LLC, provides all supervision, labor, equipment, equipment maintenance, and operational support to maintain commercial airline ramp operations and complete melting operations.
