A BILL

For an ordinance approving a proposed Fifth Amendatory Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and State of Colorado Judicial Department, for Youth and Family Treatment Court services to provide marijuana specific education, interventions, and impactful alternatives to youth struggling with marijuana.
