6 **For an ordinance changing the zoning classification for 2039 South Williams Street**
7 **in University.**

9 **WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined, based on evidence and testimony presented at
10 the public hearing, that the map amendment set forth below conforms with applicable City laws, is
11 consistent with the City’s adopted plans, furthers the public health, safety and general welfare of the
12 City, will result in regulations and restrictions that are uniform within the U-SU-C1 district, is justified
13 by one of the circumstances set forth in Section 12.4.10.8 of the Denver Zoning Code, and is
14 consistent with the neighborhood context and the stated purpose and intent of the proposed zone
15 district;

16 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**
17 **DENVER:**

18 **Section 1.** That upon consideration of a change in the zoning classification of the land area
19 hereinafter described, Council finds:

- 20 a. The land area hereinafter described is presently classified as U-SU-C.
- 21 b. It is proposed that the land area hereinafter described be changed to U-SU-C1.

22 **Section 2.** That the zoning classification of the land area in the City and County of Denver
23 described as follows shall be and hereby is changed from U-SU-C to U-SU-C1:

24 Lots 38, 39 and 40, Block 11, Evanston
25 City and County of Denver, State of Colorado

26 in addition thereto, those portions of all abutting public rights-of-way, but only to the centerline
27 thereof, which are immediately adjacent to the aforesaid specifically described area.

28 **Section 3.** That this ordinance shall be recorded by the Manager of Community Planning and
29 Development in the real property records of the Denver County Clerk and Recorder.
