29	Section 2. Monies received from sponsorships, dona	ations, and other program revenue from	
30	events, including but not limited to the sale of promotional items marketed for the event, paid to the		
31	City, for Accounting No. 11891, shall be deposited into the	•

1	Section 3. Expenditures are hereby authorized for the "OHR Special Events and Programs"

4	service contracts, event goods and services, and other program operating expenditures. This is a		
5	revenue-based, non-lapsing fund.

8	to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
