This contract allows the City to receive and expend an annual state funds of \$1,215,754.56 per year over five (5) consecative fiscal years for a total maximum contract value of \$6,078,772.80. The funds will be to reimburse the City and County of Denver-Public Works for the annual maintenance of traffic signals, traffic signs and pavement markings on state highways within the City and County of Denver's boundaries. The state highways listed in this IGA are State Hwy 2 (Colorado Blvd); State Hwy 6; I-25 off ramps; State Hwy 26 (Alameda Ave); State Hwy 30 (Hampden Ave); State Hwy 40 (Colfax Ave); I-70 off ramps; State Hwy 83 (Leetsdale Dr/Parker); State Hwy 85 (Sante Fe); State Hwys 88 & 287 (Federal Blvd); State Hwy 95 (Sheridan Blvd); I-225 off ramps; State Hwy 265 (Brighton Blvd); I-270 on ramps; and State Hwy 285 (Hampden Ave).
