



Committee Consent Agenda

Government & Finance

- BR12-0476 Approves the purchase portion of a lease/purchase agreement among the City, C&M Golf Equipment, and All American Investment Group under which All American Investment Group purchases turf-related equipment from C & M Equipment. City costs to lease the equipment are outlined in companion bill, CB12-0477.
- BR12-0477 Approves a 5 year turf equipment capital lease (through 2016) not to exceed \$2,260,000 with All American Investment Group for equipment for Parks and Recreation and the Golf Division with principal of \$2,151,525 and an interest rate of 1.80%. Companion bill to CB12-0476.
- BR12-0478 Approves a seven-year contract with CitiBank for purchasing Credit Cards for city employees (bid with the State of Colorado) under which the City receives a higher rebate rate than the current provider, estimated at approximately \$250,000 annually (GENRL-201102746-00).

Health, Safety, Education & Services

- RR12-0467 Approves the Mayoral appointment of Barb Evans-Small to the Denver Commission on Aging for a term effective immediately and expiring August 31, 2013, or until a successor is duly appointed.

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

- RR12-0471 Sets a public hearing before City Council on August 13, 2012, on the proposed Ironworks Foundry Urban Redevelopment Plan for 3350 Brighton in Council District 9.
- RR12-0479 Dedicates a parcel as part of the public right-of-way of W. Colfax near its intersection with Zenobia as part of site development for the Renaissance West End Flats in Council District 1.

RR12- Grants a revocable permit to RedPeak Properties to encroach into public
0480 right-of-way with items such as a foundation wall, concrete slab, drains, stairs and handrail in Pennsylvania and 18th Ave. for a residential development in Council District 8.

RR12- Dedicates a parcel as part of the public right-of way of the alley near W.
0482 Colfax and Zenobia as part of site development for Renaissance West End Flats in Council District 1.

BR12- Approves a \$1,262,711 contract with BT Construction for Storm Sewer
0481 improvements at 5th and Newport in Council District 5. (201205219).

Routine, non-controversial requests for ordinances that are not substantive policy changes may be placed on Consent Agendas for Council Committees each week with the approval of Committee chairs. Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion.
