## 6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:

Two projects from the 1998 bonds --Vanderbilt Park renovation and Yale/Syracuse Intersection renovation--remain undone because of delays caused by parties outside the City. This ordinance rescinds the unspent budgets that remain from the completed projects in 1998 GO Bonds and appropriates the remaining budgets and cash to these two projects. These two projects were originally authorized by Council in the companion ordinance for the Neighborhood Bonds.

In addition, there are cash balances in excess of the remaining appropriated budgets on the City's books. These came from investment earnings not previously appropriated. The cash balances for each bond question are segregated into a parent account.

One bond question (Health Care) has a cash shortfall of \$6.08. Cash cannot be transferred between bond questions, so to close this out on the City's books, we are transferring that amount of cash from 31000 to 37030.

The projects to which funds will be appropriated are:

<u>Vanderbilt Park</u> – Rescind and appropriate \$38,705.64 in remaining budget plus appropriate remaining cash in parent fund (approximately \$67,800). The addition of this \$106,505 would increase the total amount appropriated for this project to \$753,107.

<u>Yale and Syracuse</u> - Rescind and appropriate \$155,350.24 in remaining budget plus appropriate remaining cash in parent fund (approximately \$69,183). The addition of this \$224,533 would increase the total amount appropriated for this project to \$640,078.

However, as a point of information to City Council and the Mayor's Office, only these two construction projects remain to be completed. *Vanderbilt Park* was to be constructed by Cherokee in conjunction with development of that private project. However, with that project on hold, the City will go ahead with the parts of the project that it can complete, such as lake rehabilitation. *Yale and Syracuse Intersection was* eliminated in the original companion ordinance to the bonds but was removed by ordinance later because of inability to obtain cooperation with Arapahoe County. After a recent agreement with Arapahoe County and their participating in the funding, Denver is able to complete this project. The public art component of the Quincy road project, recently completed, also remains.
