Sec. 42-63.5. Acting Pay.

Effective January 1, 2002 2015, a deputy chief who, for a period of four (4) hours or more, is temporarily assigned to act as chief of police shall be compensated at the pay rate of chief of police, in lieu of the salary of deputy chief, for the time which he or she is assigned to act as chief of police; a division chief or commander who, for a period of four (4) hours or more, is temporarily assigned to act as deputy chief shall be compensated at the pay rate of deputy chief; in lieu of the salary of division chief or commander, for the time which he or she is temporarily assigned to act as division chief shall be compensated at the pay rate of division chief, in lieu of the salary of commander, for the time which he or she is assigned to division chief.
