A BILL

for an ordinance amending Chapter 42 of the Revised Municipal Code to establish the 2015, 2016 and 2017 salaries and fringe benefits of the Police Chief, Deputy Chiefs, Division Chiefs and Commanders.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That effective January 1, 2015, Chapter 42, Article II, Division 3, Section 42-53 of the Revised Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 42-53. Same---Police chief, deputy chiefs, division chiefs, and commanders.

(a) Effective January 1, ~~2013~~ **2015**, the chief of police, deputy chiefs, division chiefs, and commanders shall receive the following annual salaries:

Police chief	\$171,554	<u>\$177,601</u>
Deputy chief	\$159,583	<u>\$165,208</u>
Division chief	\$151,989	<u>\$157,347</u>
Commander	\$138,165	<u>\$143,035</u>

(b) Effective January 1, ~~2014~~ **2016**, the chief of police, deputy chiefs, division chiefs, and commanders shall receive the following annual salaries:

Police chief	\$173,270	<u>\$183,817</u>
Deputy chief	\$161,179	<u>\$170,991</u>
Division chief	\$153,509	<u>\$162,854</u>
Commander	\$139,547	<u>\$148,042</u>

(c) Effective January 1, 2017, the chief of police, deputy chiefs, division chiefs, and commanders shall receive the following annual salaries:

<u>Police chief</u>	<u>\$187,494</u>
<u>Deputy chief</u>	<u>\$174,410</u>
<u>Division chief ...</u>	<u>\$166,111</u>
<u>Commander</u>	<u>\$151,002</u>

1 (d) Effective July 1, 2017, the chief of police, deputy chiefs, division chiefs, and
2 commanders shall receive the following annual salaries:

3 Police chief \$191,244

4 Deputy chief \$177,899

5 Division chief\$169,433

6 Commander \$154,022

8 Section 2. That effective January 1, 2015, Chapter 42, Article II, Division 3, Section 42-63.5
9 of the Revised Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

11 Sec. 42-63.5. Acting Pay.

13 Effective January 1, ~~2002~~ 2015, a deputy chief who, for a period of four (4) hours or
14 more, is temporarily assigned to act as chief of police shall be compensated at the pay rate
15 of chief of police, in lieu of the salary of deputy chief, for the time which he or she is
16 assigned to act as chief of police; a division chief or commander who, for a period of four (4)
17 hours or more, is temporarily assigned to act as deputy chief shall be compensated at the pay rate
18 of deputy chief, in lieu of the salary of division chief or commander, for the time which he or she is
19 assigned to deputy chief; and, a commander who, for a period of four (4) hours or more, is
20 temporarily assigned to act as division chief shall be compensated at the pay rate of division chief,
21 in lieu of the salary of commander, for the time which he or she is assigned to division chief.
