A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing expenditures in the Public Safety Special Revenue Fund based on a letter of intent from the Office of National Drug Control Policy to award funding for the “High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (H.I.D.T.A) FY13” program.

Section 1. Expenditures are hereby authorized from the Public Safety Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 12000, the amounts of money in the following tabulation to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
