5 **A BILL**

6 **For an Ordinance approving a proposed purchase by the City and County of**  
7 **Denver (“City”) of insurance coverage from: Kaiser Foundation Health Plan of**  
8 **Colorado; UnitedHealthcare Insurance Company; Denver Health Medical Plan,**  
9 **Inc.; Delta Dental of Colorado; Standard Insurance Company; Vision Service**  
10 **Plan Insurance Company.**

12 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 18-5(c), Denver Revised Municipal Code (“D.R.M.C.”), the  
13 Office of Human Resources Executive Director has consulted with the employee health insurance  
14 committee and recommends to City Council the following employee benefit changes to the  
15 insurance policies and agreements between the City and entities set forth below.

16 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 18-5(c), D.R.M.C., City Council may accept, reject or  
17 modify any benefit recommendations made by the Director.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY**  
19 **OF DENVER:**

20 **Section 1.** The proposed purchase of insurance coverage by the City from **Kaiser**  
21 **Foundation Health Plan of Colorado**, in the words and figures contained and set forth in the Rate  
22 Sheets and plan descriptions as presented at Committee and attached hereto, is hereby approved.

23 **Section 2.** The proposed purchase of insurance coverage by the City from  
24 **UnitedHealthcare Insurance Company**, in the words and figures contained and set forth in the  
25 Rate Sheets and plan descriptions as presented at Committee and attached hereto, is hereby  
26 approved.

27 **Section 3.** The proposed purchase of insurance coverage by the City from **Denver**  
28 **Health Medical Plan, Inc.**, in the words and figures contained and set forth in the Rate Sheets and  
29 plan descriptions as presented at Committee and attached hereto, is hereby approved.

30 **Section 4.** The proposed purchase of insurance coverage for basic life, accidental death  
31 and dismemberment, and long term disability insurance by the City from **Standard Insurance**  
32 **Company**, in the words and figures contained and set forth in the Rate Sheets and plan  
33 descriptions as presented at Committee and attached hereto, is hereby approved.

34 **Section 5.** The Office of Human Resources Executive Director, and the Human  
35 Resources Director of the Denver Police Department are hereby authorized to perform all of the  
36 duties and undertake all of the responsibilities needed to effectuate the insurance policies and

1 agreements between the City and entities set forth above in this ordinance, as contemplated by  
2 and consistent with this ordinance.
