- 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved**
 - a. Scope of Work**

Crime Prevention and Control Commission has contracted with the State Judicial Department to support probation officers to manage misdemeanor cases in Drug Court; and a magistrate in Drug Court; and provide juvenile mental health and gang prevention services. The proposed contract provides for a cumulative total that exceeds the threshold contained in Section 3.2.6(E) of the Charter requiring City Council approval. The proposed amendment adds \$246,323.67 resulting in the current cumulative cost of \$1,648,259.67 since 2006. The contract amount is being reduced by 74% as we are eliminating the juvenile municipal mental health position; the State of Colorado is picking up one probation position and costs of the Magistrate starting State FY 2011. Contract ends December 2011.
