This ordinance request is for a consultant contract to implement an alternatives analysis and environmental assessment as part of a Federal Transit Administration (FTA) grant.

The City applied for and was granted an FTA Alternatives analysis grant in the amount of \$2,000,000 through a national competitive funding process in 2010. The alternatives analysis/environmental assessment will analyze transit alternatives to meet a 20 – 30% increase in person-trip demand in the East Colfax corridor by 2030. The existing transit and roadway corridor is currently at capacity for much of the day.
