This ordinance will authorize the appropriation of the 2014 funding from the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) authorized by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Awarded annually, the Emergency Solutions Grant has provided a stable source of funds to help meet emergency services needed to address the amelioration of poverty. The grant program operates on a fiscal year beginning July 1st. For the FY 2014, it is estimated that Denver Human Services will be awarded \$507,585.00 based on the Letter of Intent received. Based on this information, we are requesting to appropriate 50% of the grant award to ensure continuation of services. Official grant awards letters are generally not received until the spring.
