- 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved**
 - a. Scope of Work**

Classification Notice #1360 – Combination Inspector I (622-T), Combination Inspector II (624-T), Chief Trades Inspector (812-T) and Trades Inspector (621-T) are new classes. Public Safety Inspector (621-T) is recommended for abolishment. The Community Planning and Development department has been working for several years on developing trades inspection staff that can perform inspections in more than one trades area. This saves the department time and is a more efficient use of resources. Instead of sending several inspectors out to the same location, the goal is to dispatch one inspector who has the needed licenses and/or certifications and experience to inspect work in several trades areas at the same location. The department has established an extensive training program to assist employees in obtaining the needed training for obtaining the required licenses and/or certifications. There is no budget impact.
